<b>Workshop Objectives</b>	By the end of the workshop, learners will have the relevant knowledge and application skills in CPR and Bandaging to apply during an emergency or accident for felines or canines. <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Identify common medical conditions requiring first aid treatment.</li><li>2. Manage a medical emergency related to felines and canines.</li><li>3. Apply first aid to felines or canines in the community.</li><li>4. Apply the use of CPR to unconscious felines or canines.</li></ol>
