Course Description	For Parents, Domestic helpers, Nannies, Babysitters, Volunteers and Individuals who are interested in learning to rendering First Aid to Child and Infant.
Course Objective	By the end of the course, learners will have the relevant knowledge and application skills to apply during an emergency or accident: 1. Check and pack contents of First Aid Kit 2. Perform First Aid treatment for common medical emergencies at home for Child and Infant 3. Perform Foreign Body Airway Obstruction (Conscious and Unconscious) effectively on Child and Infant casualties. 4. Perform Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) effectively on Child and Infant unconscious casualties.

In case of doubt, please consult your doctor first and produce a Letter/Memo to indicate if fit for training.
